We warmly welcome you to our community of faith and we hope you will want to worship with us regularly.



INSTRUMENTS

We have two fine instruments in the sanctuary at St. Paul's, a three manual pipe organ with digital enhancement and an 1877 Knabe Grand Piano that was donated to the church in 1997 and completely rebuilt. We also have a grand piano in the Music Room.



We offer Sunday School Classes every Sunday morning for all ages. Children join their parents for the beginning of the service and proceed to class mid service. The Children & Youth Team host a variety of fun activities throughout the year, including the popular Mystery Friend Program.
